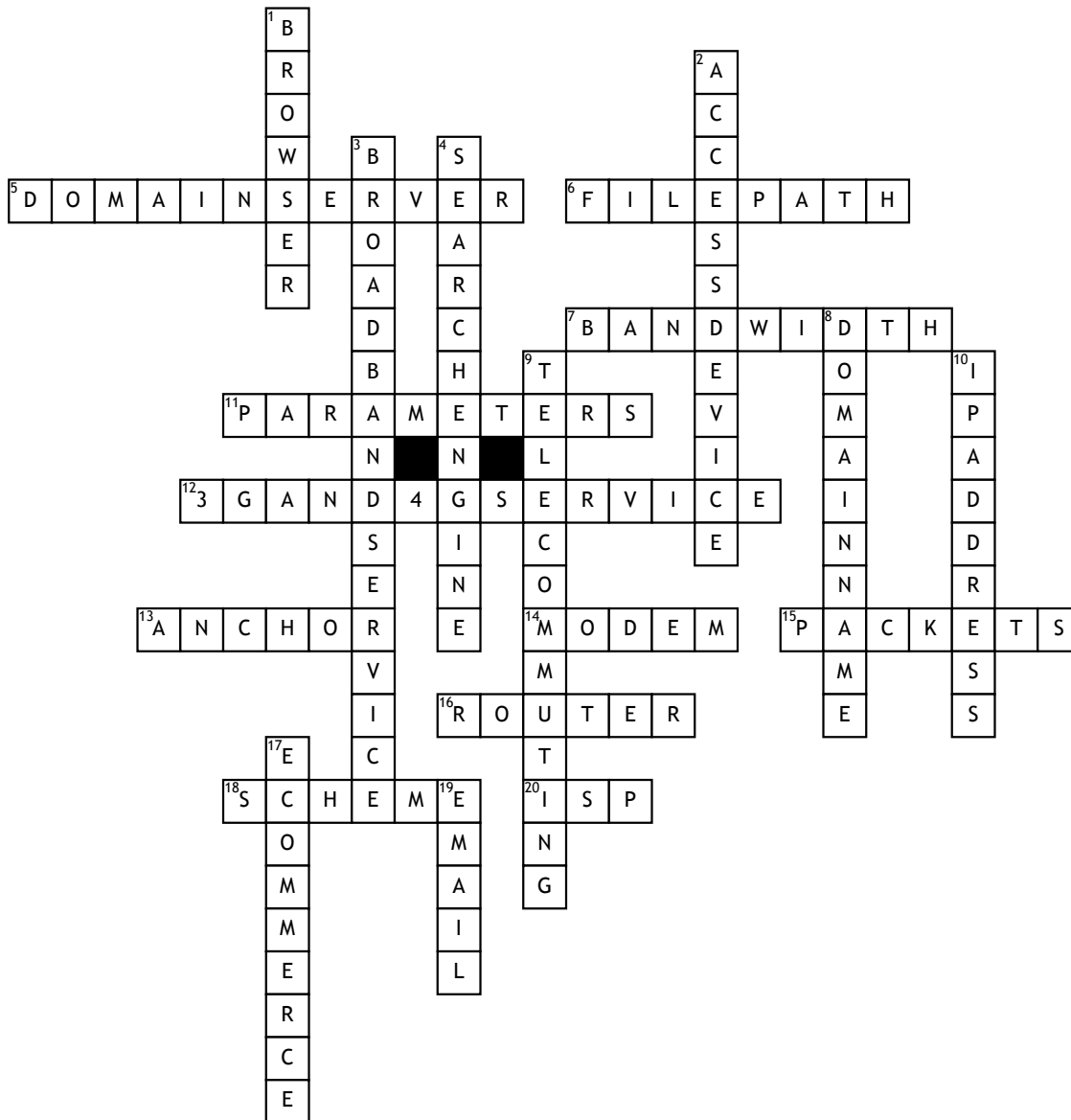

7. Maximum data transfer rate of a network or Internet connection. It measures how much data can be sent over a specific connection in a given amount of time.

12. Type of internet service that connects wirelessly through mobile phone services.

16. Device that forwards data packets along networks. It is connected to at least two networks either LANs or WANs.
