12. A person who generally does not feel sexual attraction or desire to any group of people.

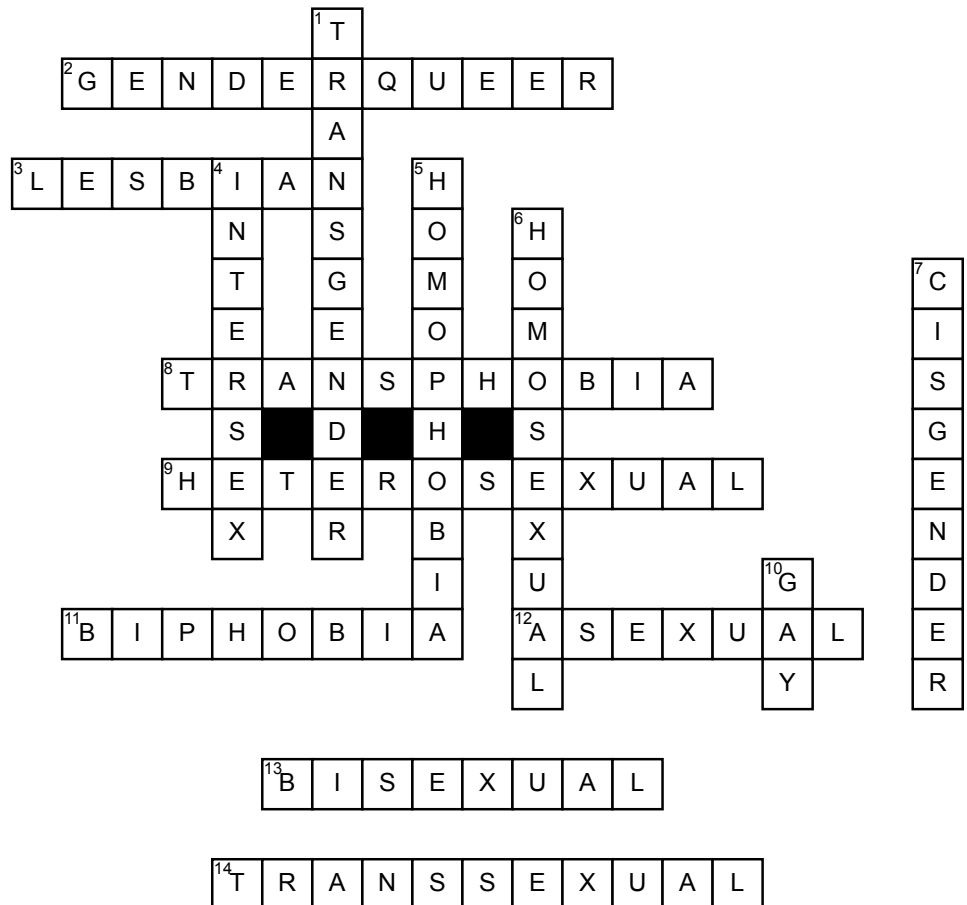
13. A person who is attracted to both people of their own gender and another gender.
