


Lower Leg, foot and ankle

3. blood supply to tibias posterior
 8. vessel to the peroneus longus
 9. inserts on the 5th metatarsal tuberosity
 11. causes dorsiflexion and eversion of the ankle
 15. ligament that stabilizes the talocrural joint
 17. protrusion on the tibia
 20. the tibias anterior causes what movement at the ankle?

21. major posterior tarsal bone (attachment of soleus)
 22. causes flexion of the great toe

1. insets at the clacaneus and is supplied by the popliteal artery
 2. inserts in the phalanges
 4. inserts on the base of the distal phalynx of the great toe
 5. membrane between the tibia and fibula
 6. articulation point between the fibula and femur

7. creates the tarsal tunnel
 10. articulate with metatarsals and navicular
 12. joint that causes inversion and eversion at the ankle
 13. nerve to the soleus
 14. located deep to the gastrocnemius
 16. medial leg bone
 18. joint formed by the tibia, fibula and talus
 19. how many heads does the gastrocnemius have?
