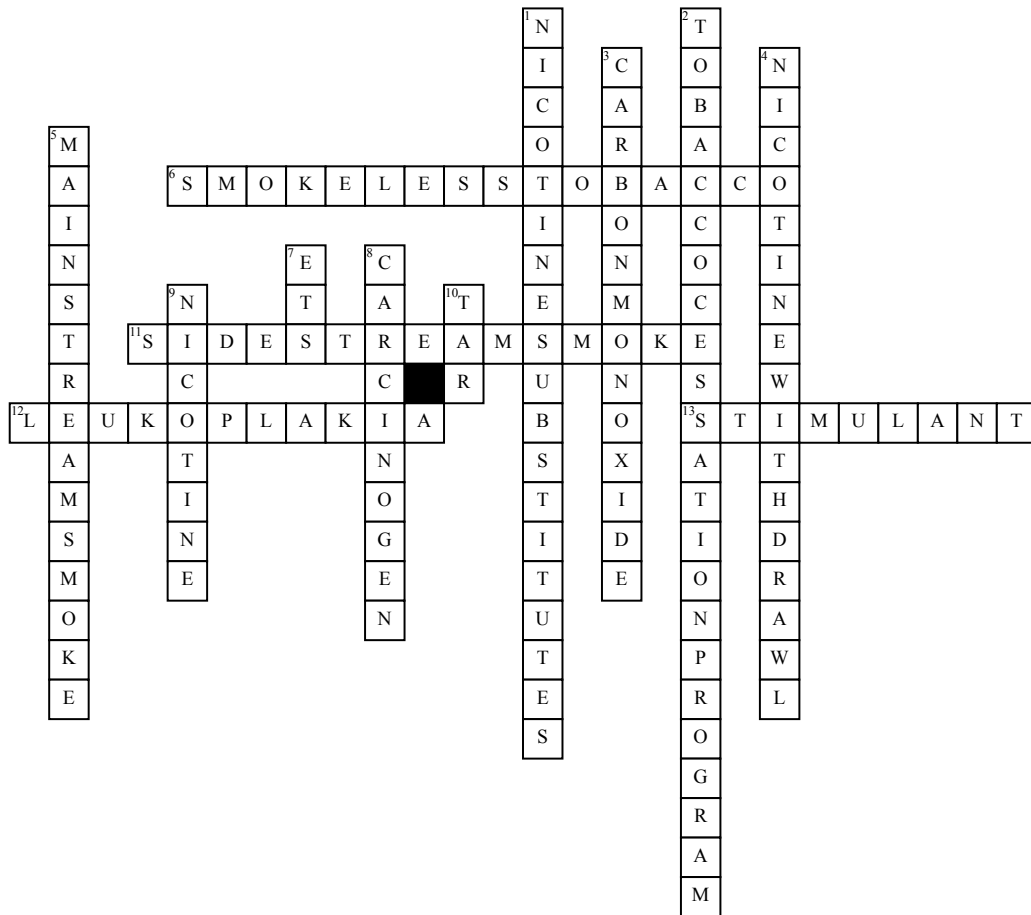


Tobacco
