

1. Production of abnormally large volumes of dilute urine.

3. A protrusion of the meninges through a gap in the spine due to a congenital defect.

4. A condition characterized by excess fluid in a kidney due to a backup of urine.

5. Defined as a urine output.

6. Inflammation of the kidney due to a bacterial infection.

7. Medication used to treat myasthenia gravis, Ogilvie syndrome, and urinary retention without the presence of a blockage.

8. A cuplike cavity or structure, in particular.

9. Softening of the bones, typically through a deficiency of vitamin D or calcium.

11. Term given to excessive thirst and is one of the initial symptoms of diabetes.
