

 Outward rotation of the legs from the hip socket to the feet.
Chase, a gliding action where the feet kiss in the air.

8. Snapping the focus and head during a turn to help diminish dizziness and clarify the turn.

9. back, side, front

10. A turn performed on one leg with the other leg in passé.12. 180 turn with shift of weight

15. step cross, rock side, step in place

16. to bend; Sinking down, both knees bend and straighten in unison.

<u>Down</u>

2. Position of the foot at the knee with toes pointed.

3. feet and knees facing forward 5. a straight-leg kick passing through the tendu and degage, brushing quickly to 90 degrees or higher. 6. to stretch; To fully extend the foot to a point on the floor.7. Chain or link; small rapid turns done in succession with half-turn on each foot.

11. To Disengage- a quick brush of the straight leg through tendu to a position slightly off the floor.

13. To rise; standing on the balls of the feet with heels lifted as high as possible

14. place the ball of the foot on the floor without changing weight
