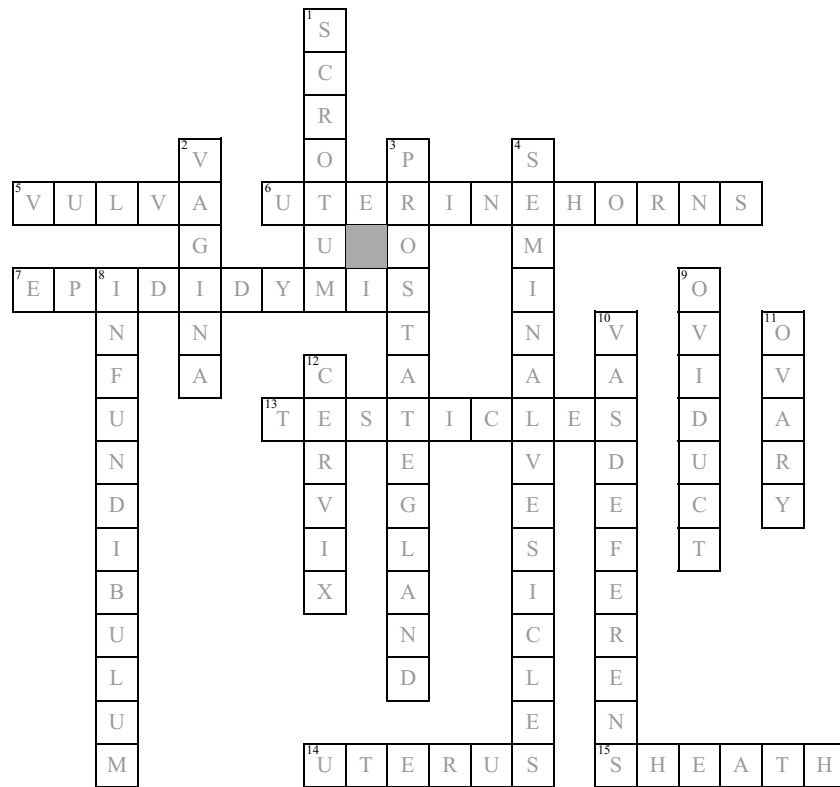


Animal Reproduction



Across

- External opening of the reproductive and urinary systems.
- The fertilized egg attaches to the uterine walls and develops here?
- Sperm is stored here until maturation.
- Produce hormones associated with reproduction and male gametes.
- Location where the fertilized egg develops.
- Protects the penis when relaxed.

Down

- Carries the testicles and regulates their temperature.
- Semen is deposited into the reproductive system through here?
- Releases fluid that mixes with the seminal fluid and nourishes sperm.
- Produce fluid that transport and protect sperm.
- Receives the egg from the ovary.
- A tube-like structure that carries the egg from the ovary to the uterus.
- Transports sperm from the epididymis to the urethra.
- Produce the female sex cells called eggs.
- Functions as a passageway for sperm and keeps bacteria/foreign material out of the uterus during pregnancy.
