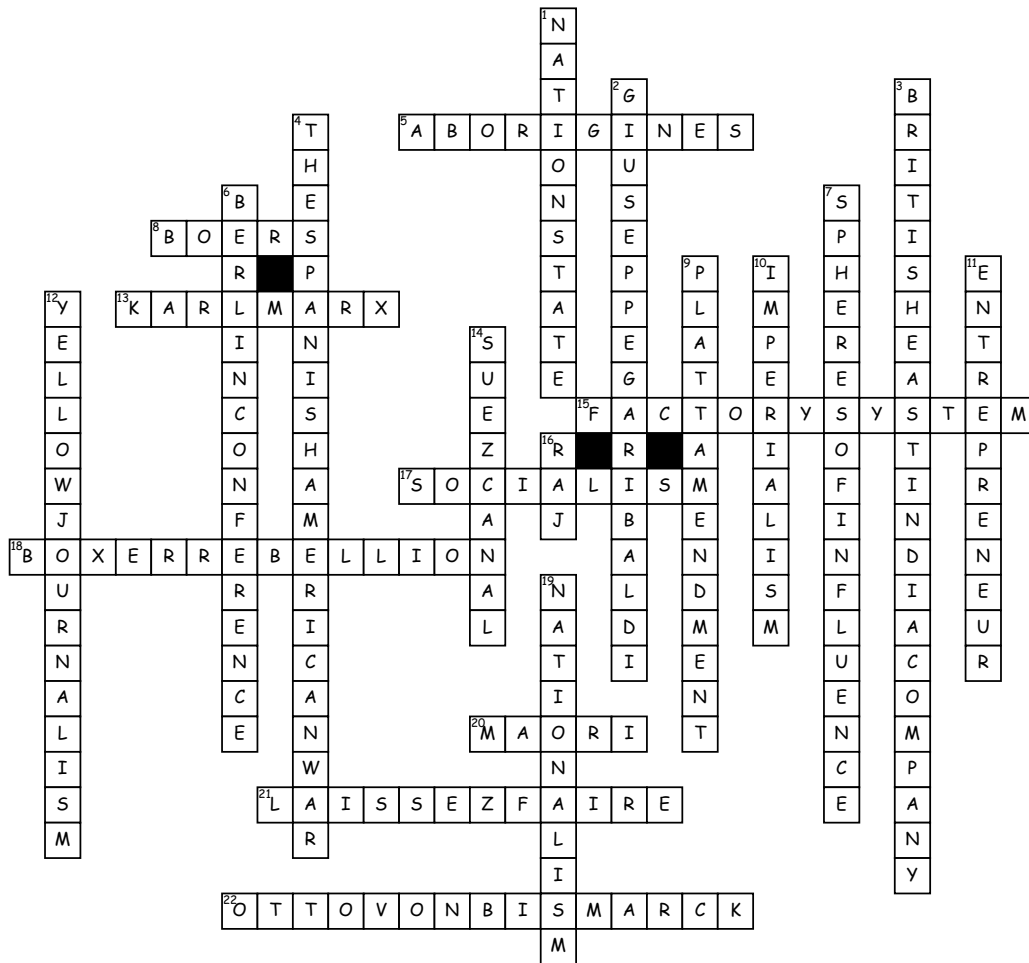


# Industrial Revolution Crossword
