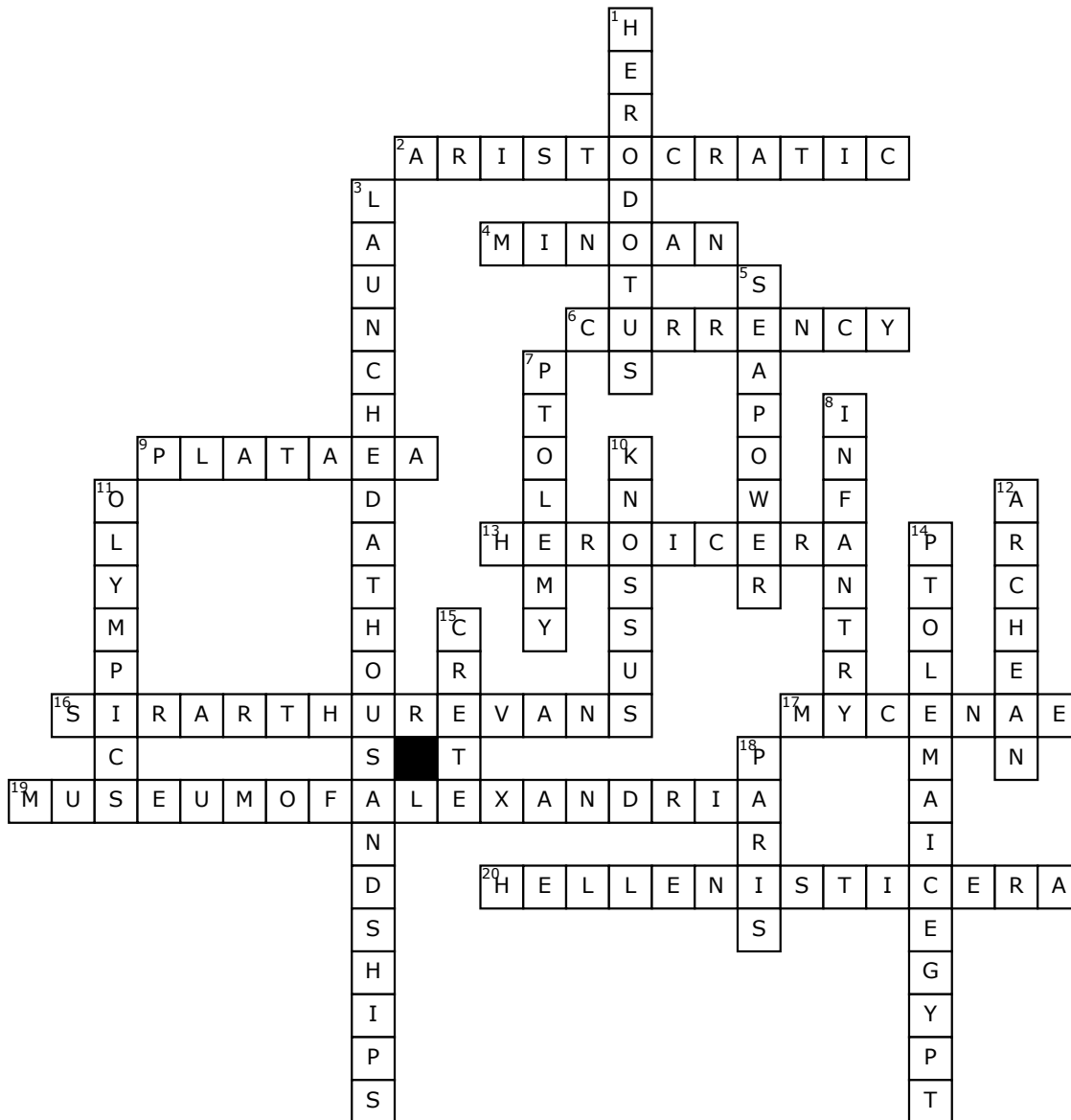


Ancient Greek Crossword Puzzle
