
Winter Olympic Sports

- **5.** a sport that involves descending a snow-covered slope while standing on a board attached to a rider's feet
- 7. a sport in which players slide stones on a sheet of ice towards a target area which is segmented into four concentric circles
- **8.** a winter sliding sport in which a person rides a small sled, known as a skeleton bobsled (or -sleigh), down a frozen track while lying face down (prone)
- **9.** a winter sport in which teams of two or four teammates make timed runs down narrow, twisting, banked, iced tracks in a gravity-powered sled.
- 10. a competitive form of ice skating in which the competitors race each other in travelling a certain distance on skates

- **2.** a competitive winter sport in which the participant uses skis to glide on snow
- **3.** a sport in which individuals, duos, or groups perform on figure skates on ice
- **4.** a contact team sport played on ice, usually in a rink, in which two teams of skaters use their sticks to shoot a vulcanized rubber puck into their opponent's net to score points
- **6.** a small one- or two-person sled on which one sleds supine (face up) and feet-first
