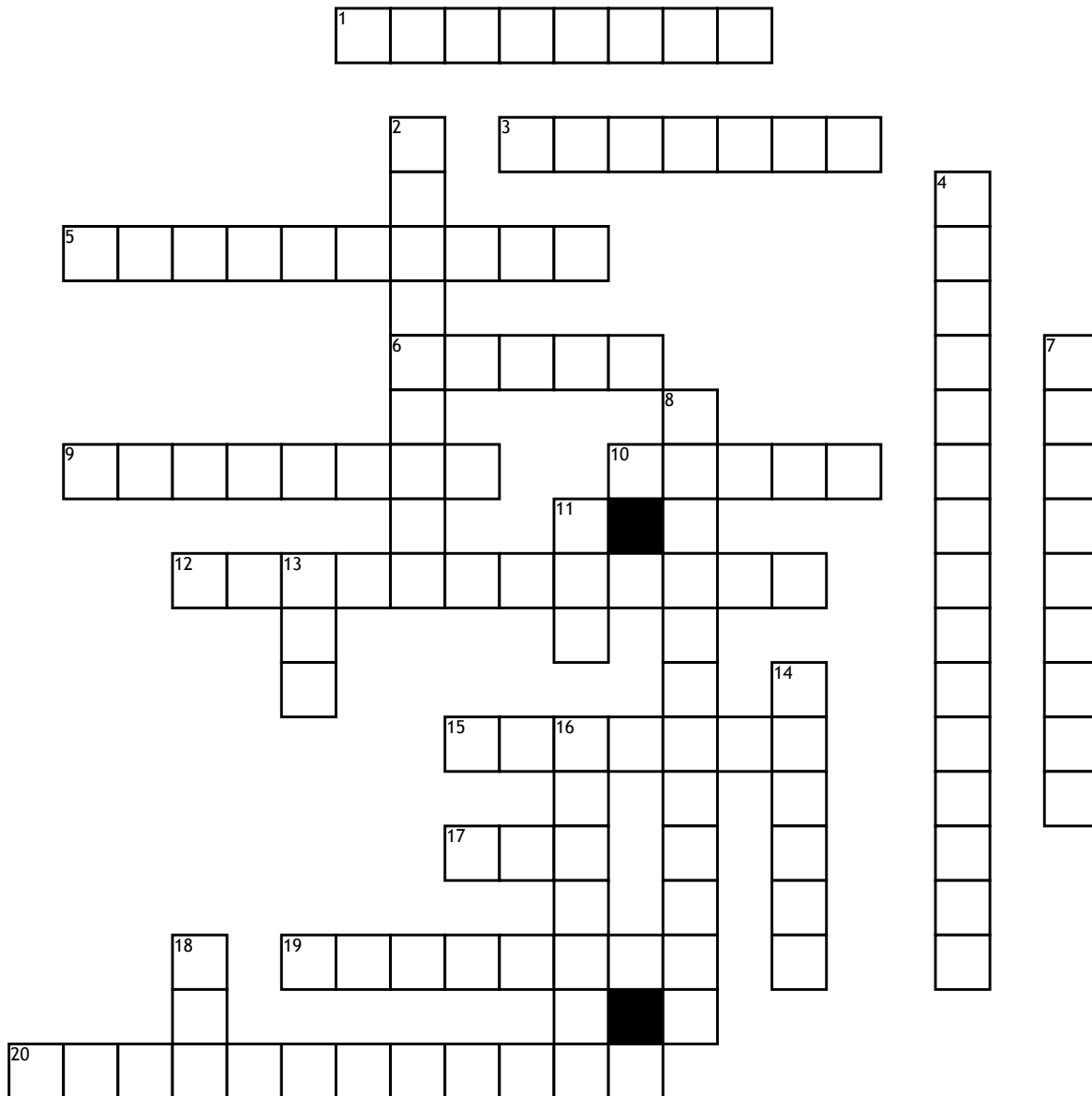


Chapter 22-Illegal drugs
