5. Starts every formula.
6. A prewritten formula (Average, Sum, etc.
7. displays the worksheet as it will appear when printed.
8. The number format that causes the cells to display with two decimal places.
9. a box that is made when each column and row meets.
10. a series of two or more adjacent cells in a column, row, or rectangle.
11. displays data being entered in a cell
12. a number, such as a whole number, a fraction, or a decimal
