

1. The act of rounding up Christians and killing them causing foreign powers to respond quickly

2. Connected the Mediterranean with the Red Sea

3. The Muslim leader of Egypt, saw the slow decline of the Ottoman Empire 4. Most valuable of all

5. Stated that the American continents are free and independent and are not subjective to further colonization by European powers

6. Russia hoped to win control of the Black Sea so it could ship grain across the Mediterranean. In 1853, war broke out between Russia and the Ottomans
7. New leader to help the nationalist movement and unite Indians across class lines
