

4. For foliage development
9. Bulky organic material
10. A form of iron that cannot be bound up in the soil
11. An organic phosphorous fertiliser
12. Encourages root development **13.** Deficiency in Rhododendrons caused by high pH

14. Deficiency causes bitter pit and blossom end rot

<u>Down</u>

 A fertiliser supplying two or more nutrient
 A fertiliser supplying only one nutrient **3.** An organic nitrogenous fertiliser (4,3,4)

5. A fertiliser supplying several nutrients and formulated for a specific plant or group of plants

6. A form of nitrogen7. Added to soil to

lower pH

8. Encourages fruiting and flowering
