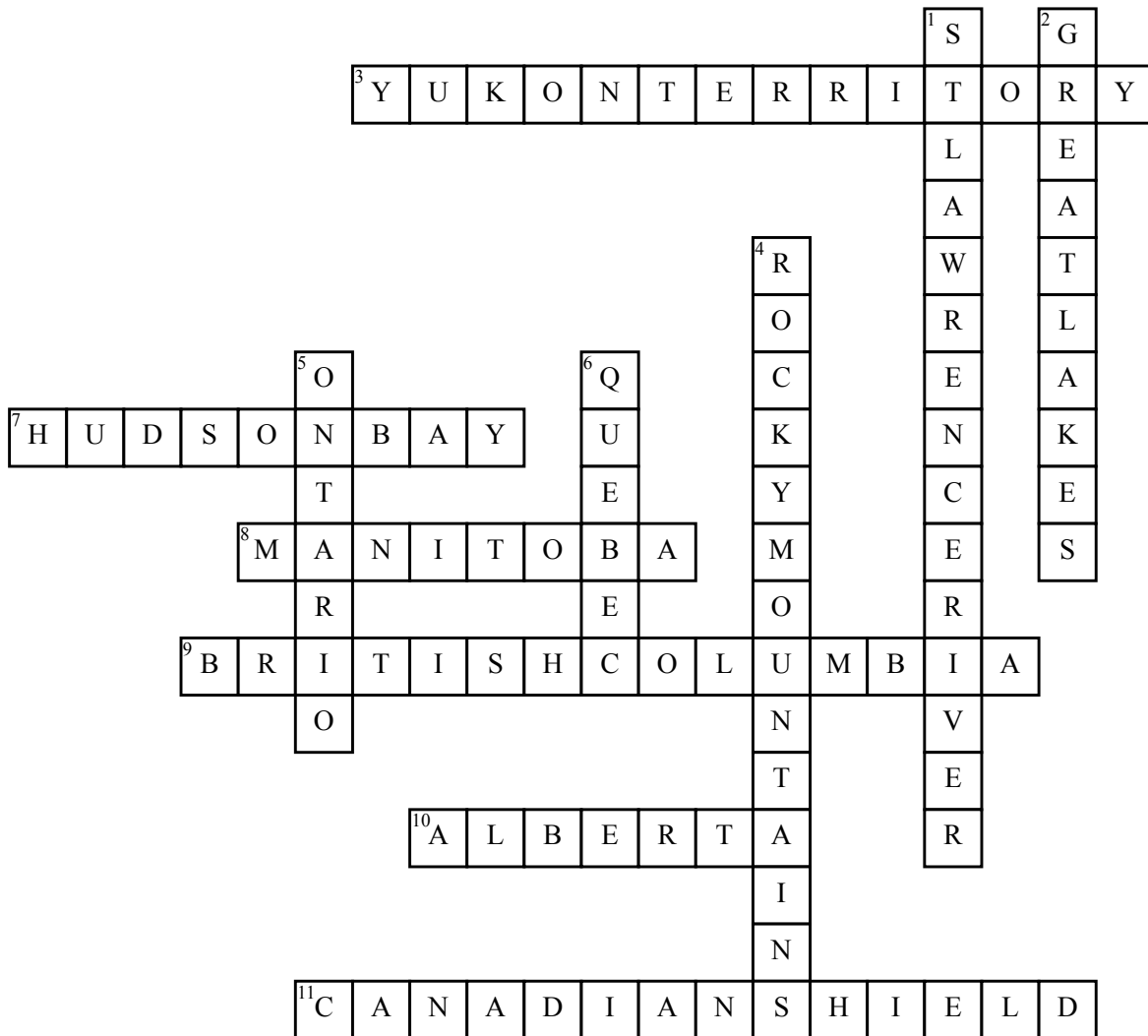


# Physical & Political Features of Canada



## Across

3. A territory in northwest Canada is wild, mountainous and sparsely populated.
7. A HUGE inland sea in east-central Canada that connects to the Atlantic Ocean.
8. Canadian province bordered by Ontario to the east and Saskatchewan to the west.
9. Canada's westernmost province that is defined by its Pacific coastline and mountain ranges.
10. This is a province in western Canada with a landscape that encompasses mountains, prairies, desert badlands, and vast coniferous forests.

11. This is a rough, rolling landscape with thin rocky soil with timber, minerals, and water being its major natural resources.

## Down

1. Flows in a roughly north-east direction, connecting the Great Lakes with the Atlantic Ocean.
2. This is known as the "industrial heartland" of the continent because of all the factories.
4. This mountain range stretches a distance of 2,000 miles from British Columbia to New Mexico.
5. Toronto is the capital of the east-central province.
6. This is a predominantly French-speaking province in eastern Canada.
