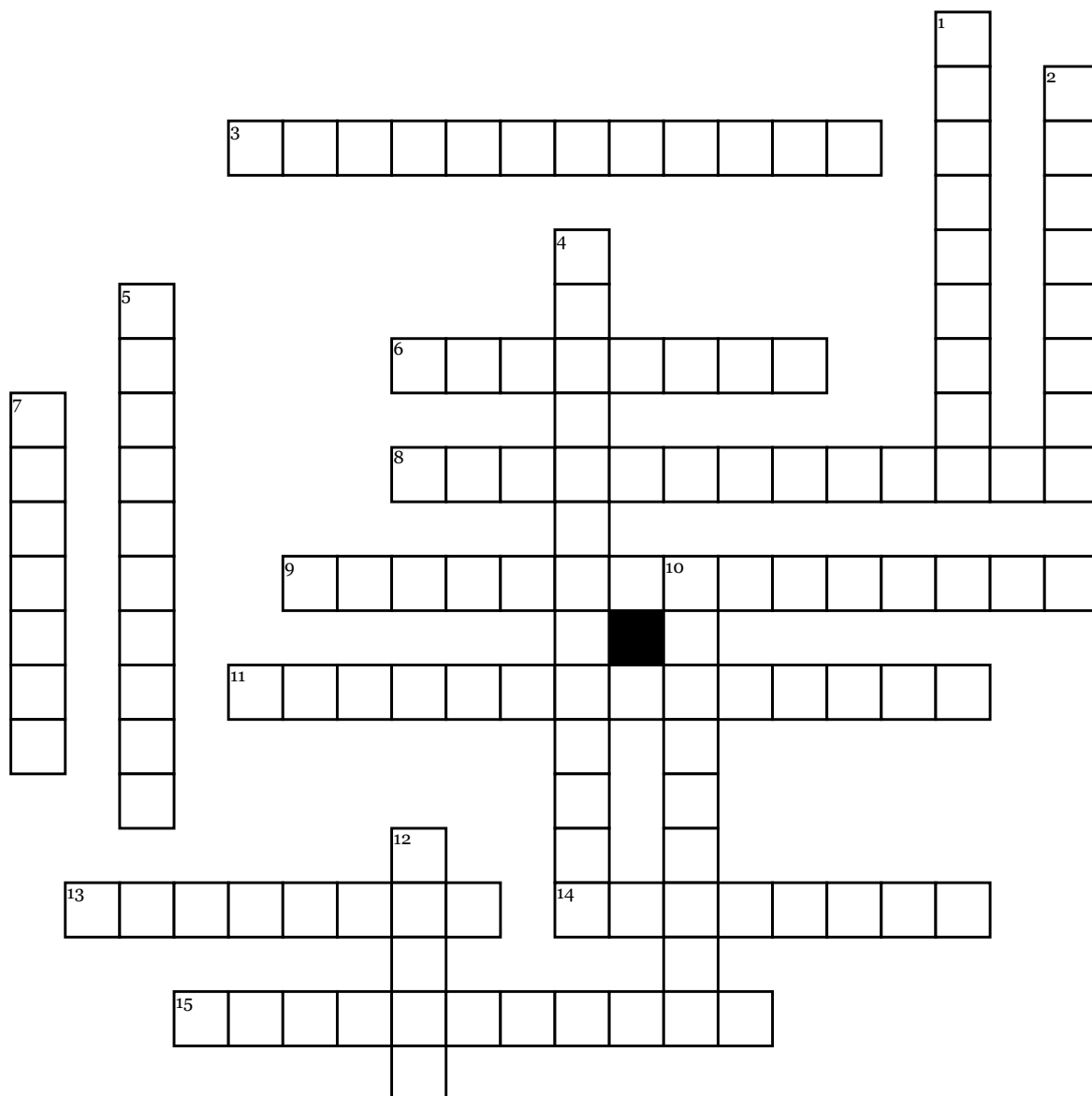

3. allows you to revert the picture to its original coloring and better fit it in the placeholder

6. pamphlet, usually is a high-quality publication with lots of color and graphics, created for advertising purposes

8. Consists of more than one object linked together for logical reasons, such as the parts of a masthead or a picture with its caption

9. Temporary storage area that holds up to 24 items (text or graphics) copied from and Office program

11. Special character that Publisher displays on the screen, but one that is not visible on a printed publication

13. Allows you to type words in a text box continually without pressing the enter key at the end of each line

14. After the placeholder is replaced with a picture, the icon changes to a swapped icon

15. Gray area that appears outside the publication page

1. Publications submitted to an outside printer, for duplicating

2. pictures are taller than they are wide

4. Allow you to easily change the basic rectangle format to a more visually appealing style and design look

5. Specialized effects and fonts, including stylistic sets, drop caps, number styles, and glyphs

7. Explanatory or identification text or title that accompanies a graphic, figure, or photo

10. Pictures are wider than they are tall

12. Process of copying an item from either clipboard into the publication at the location of the insertion point or intersection
