<u>Across</u>

3. waterproof, all-purpose tape used to hold floral foam in place; also known as anchor tape

10. land used for the burial of the deceased
11. floral arrangement made of silk or other permanent floral materials and taken to a gravesite

<u>Down</u>

1. top of a casket is half open

2. short, published notice of a person's death

4. large

bereavement arrangement made in absorbent floral foam; also called a sympathy tribute or sympathy basket

5. entire casket is closed

6. plastic form used to hold absorbent floral foam and flowers on top of a casket 7. leaves used as a group or individually in floral arrangements to add depth and cover the mechanics of an arrangement; also referred to as greenery

8. above ground building where the deceased are buried
9. supplies, methods and materials used by floral designers to hold flowers and foliage in an arrangement
