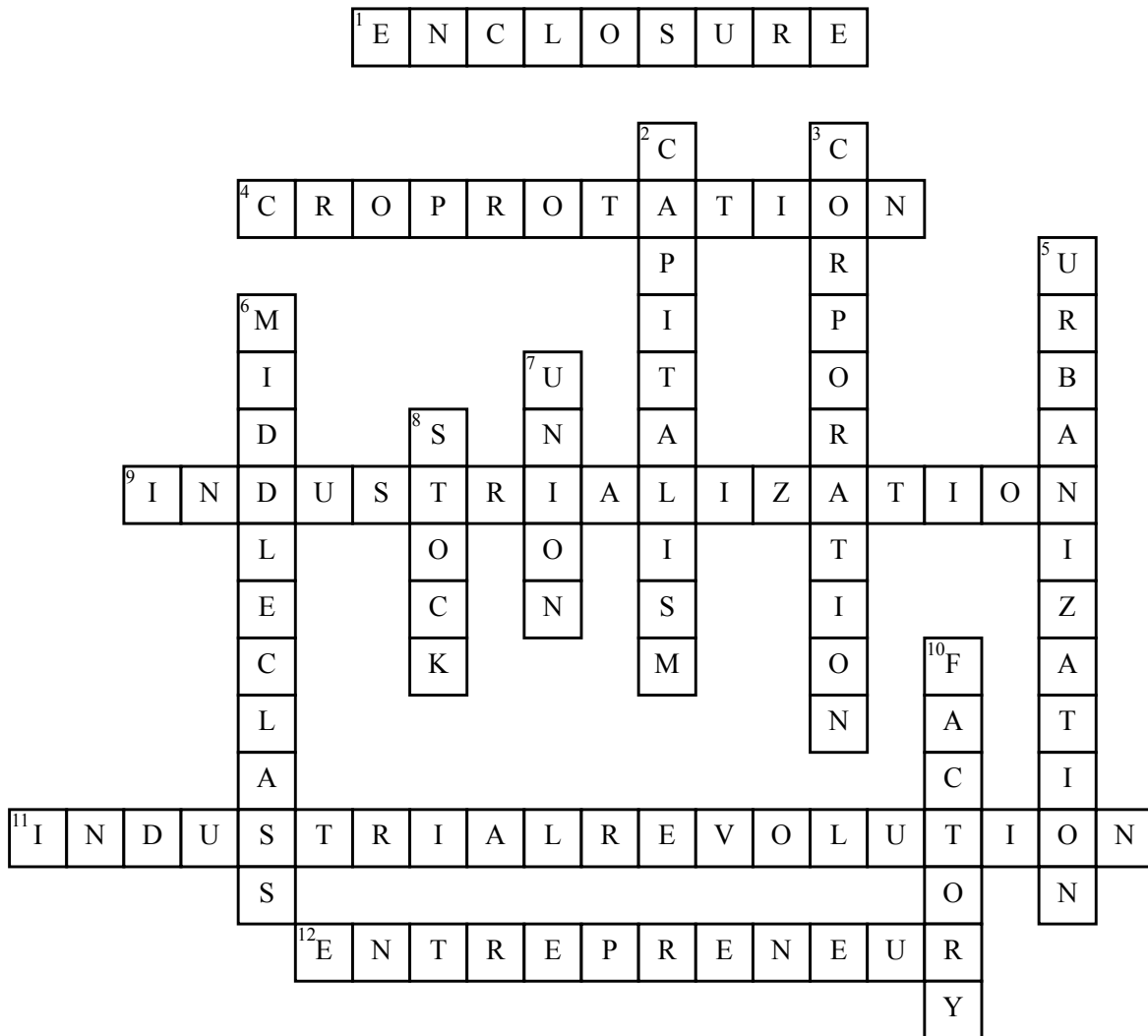


The Industrial Revolution
