

- 1. Unfounded prejudice against the Jewish people

- **4.** A wealthy disciple of Jesus and a member of the Sanhedrin who did not approve of the council's condemnation of Jesus.
- **5.** Place where Jesus prayed in agony and the soldiers came to arrest him.

- **6.** A criminal released by Pilate to the crowd, instead of Jesus, as part of a Passover custom.
- 7. The crime of insulting God or of claiming Godlike attributes. Crucifixion, a brutal form of capital punishment used by the Romans that involved nailing or tying the extremities to a wooden cross.
- 8. The high priest at the time of Jesus' crucifixion
- **9.** One of the twelve Apostles who betrays Jesus with a kiss for thirty pieces of silver.
- 10. The priest in charge of the Temple worship
