

- **1.** Place where all nerves from the retina join to form the optic nerve
- **4.** The fatty layer that surrounds each nerve fiber
- **5.** A clear fluid that helps the cornea keep its rounded shape
- 10. Focal point, center of vision
- **12.** Thick, clear jelly that helps give the eyeball its shape
- 17. Cells that respond to dim light
- **18.** The bundle of nerves fibers that carry information from the retina to the brain

- **19.** extremely sharp bladed instrument used for cutting into skin, muscle, and fat
- 20. Makes tears

- **2.** Thick, tough, white outer covering of the eyeball
- **3.** Cells in the retina that give you color vision
- **6.** Holds the lens in place
- **7.** Colorful, shiny material located behind the retina, used for night vision
- 8. Layer inside the sclera

- **9.** Clear, flexible structure that makes an image on the eye's retina
- 11. Thin, clear protective layer on top of the cornea and sclera
- **13.** Dark circle in the center of the iris, oval in a cow
- **14.** A muscle that controls how much light enters the eye, brown in the cow
- **15.** Tough, clear covering over the iris and the pupil for protection
- **16.** Layer of light-sensitive cells at the back of the eye and detects images
