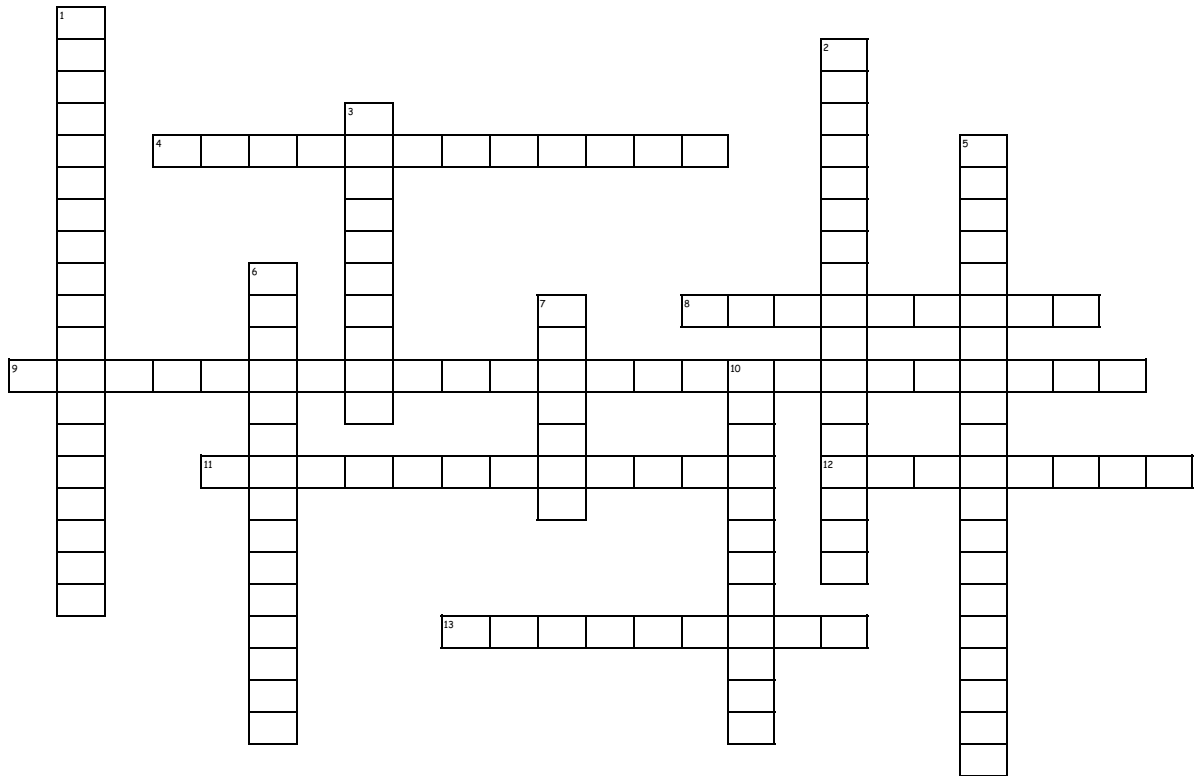

1. An amendment to the U.S. Constitution, adopted in 1865, that has abolished slavery and involuntary servitude
2. A famous speech delivered by Abraham Lincoln in November 1863, at the dedication of a national cemetery on the site of the Battle of Gettysburg
3. A northern Democrat who advocated making peace with the Confederacy during the Civil War
5. Where Lee surrendered to Grant on April 9, 1865, thus ending the Civil War
6. Legislation passed in 1863 to make banking safer for investors
7. An ironclad ship used by the North in the Civil War
