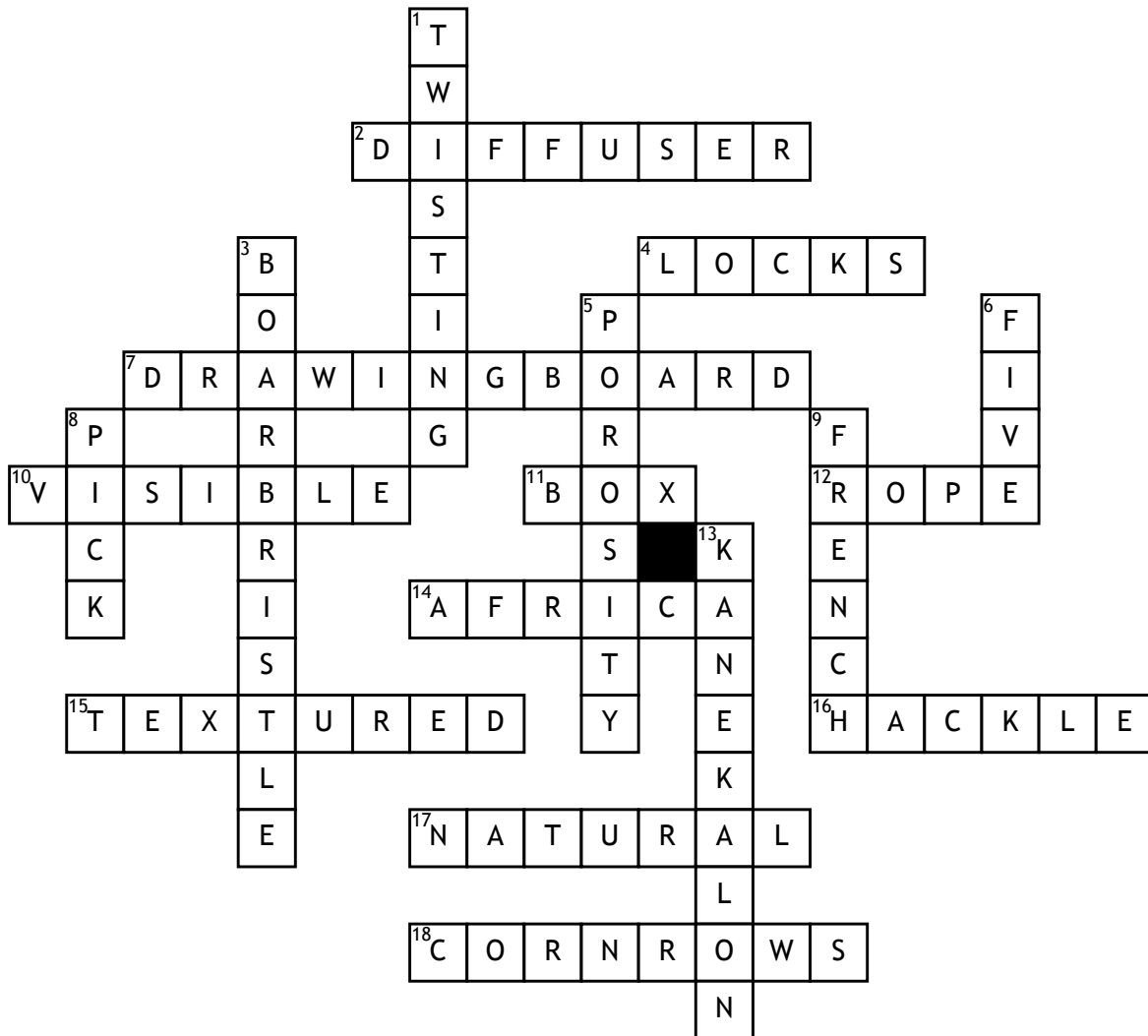

- 15. Hair with a tight, coiled pattern
- 16. A board of fine , upright nails used to comb extensions
- 17. Styling hair that does not alter the curl or coil pattern
- 18. Canerows

- 5. Ability of hair to absorb moisture
- 6. Stages of locks
- 8. Tool used to lift and seperate hair
