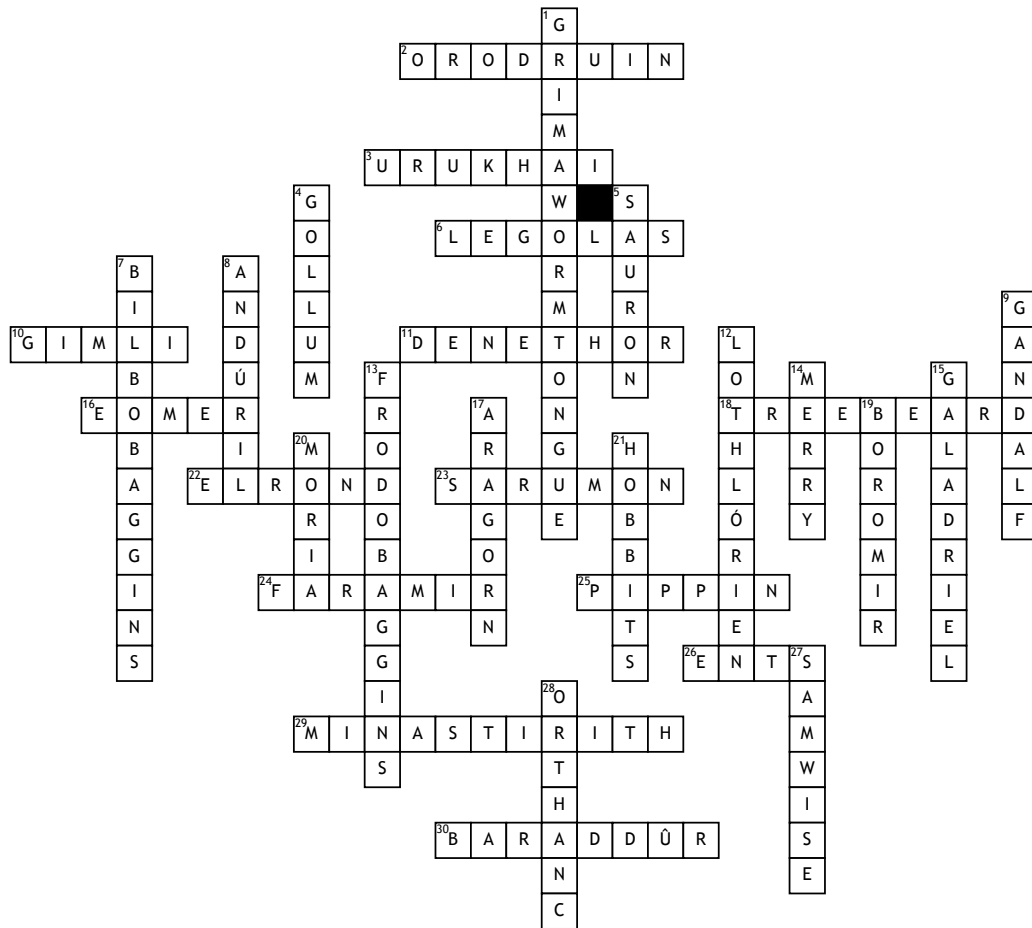

 8. This blade has the nicknames, "Flame of the West", "The Sword that was Broken", and "The Sword Reforged"; it was once called Narsil; it was first wielded by the two Kings of Gondor, Elendil and Isildur
 9. The White Wizard; was the previous Grey Wizard; a current member of the White Counsel
 12. Is known as the Golden Wood
 13. The ring bearer; one of the four halflings who were apart of the Fellowship
 14. One of the four halflings who were apart of the Fellowship; has a good friend named Pippin
 15. Lady of Lórien; one of the three Elven Lords; a member of the White Counsel; lives in Lothlórien

17. Heir to the throne of Gondor; nicknamed "Strider"; a ranger from the North; one of the two members of the Fellowship who were men
 19. The eldest son of Denethor II; was one of the two members of the Fellowship who were men
 20. The old home of the dwarves; where the Grey Wizard battled against the Balrog
 21. The fat and lazy people who love company and parties; lives in holes in the ground
 27. One of the four halflings who were apart of the Fellowship; is a servant and good friend to the ring bearer
 28. The pillar of the White Hand
