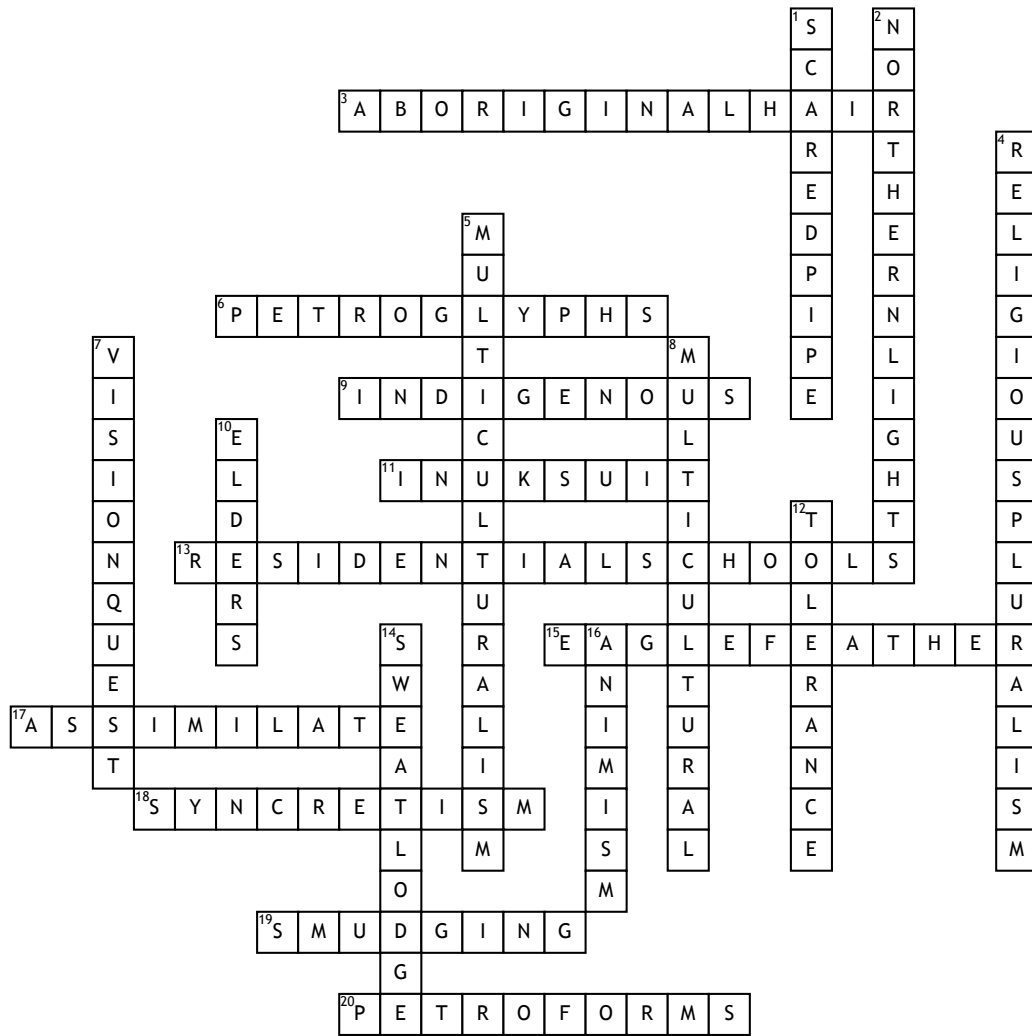


Aboriginal Crossword Puzzle

1. Symbolizes unity, and harmony in the world. Used by algonquin first nations in ceremonies and rituals.
 2. The cree believe that the northern lights are spirit of dead relatives dancing.

 5. A policy and law that recognizes and supports the diversity of a nation's or province's population.
 7. Person in search of spirit helpers will spend 3 days in a spot without food and little water.

 12. An attitude that recognizes the right of others to think, live, or worship according to their own beliefs.
