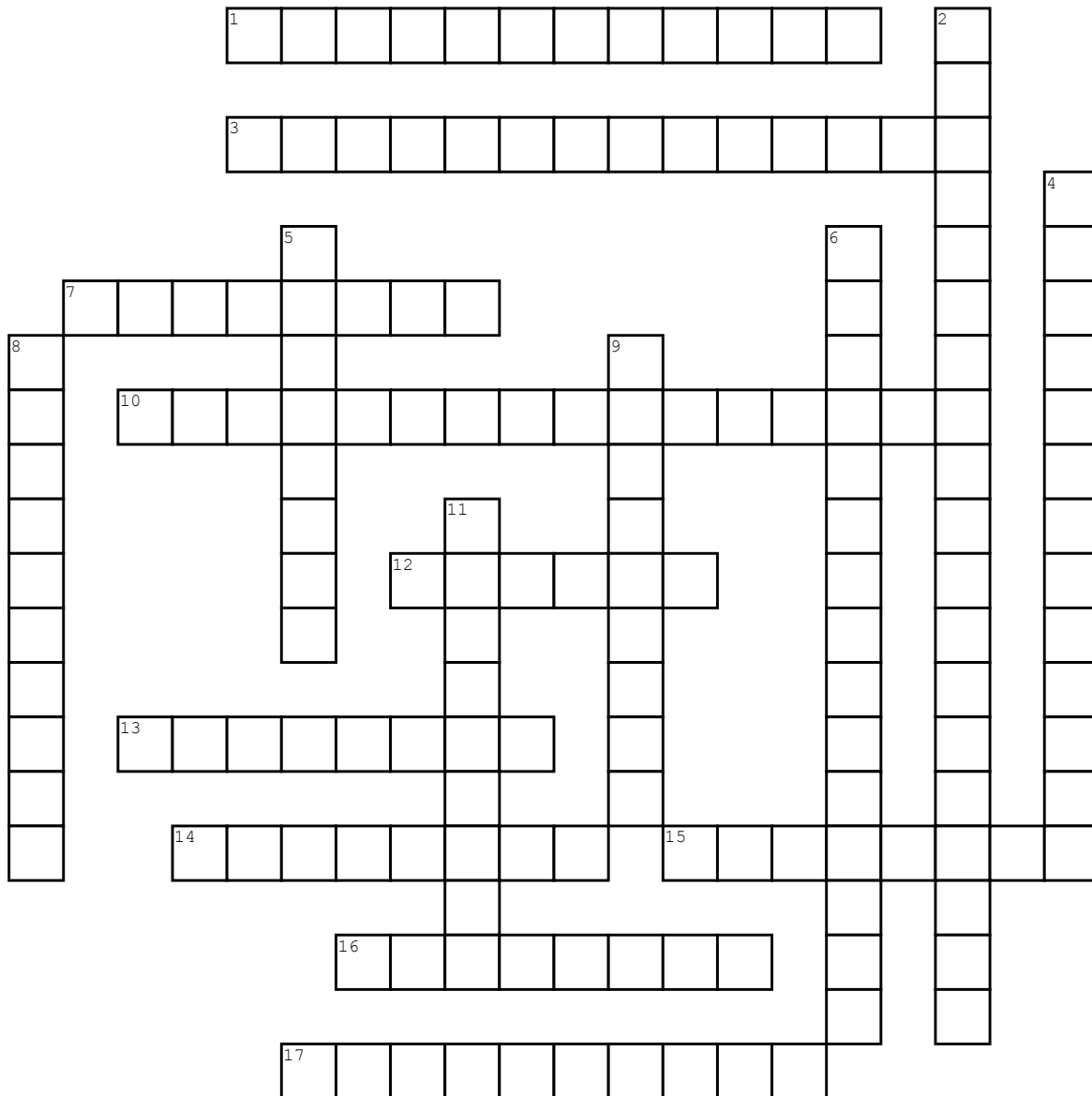


The American Revolution
