
Wound Care

3. A wound irrigation solution that has antimicrobial and excellent moisturising properties

5. A fluid with high content of protein ad cellular debris that has escaped from blood vessels due to inflammation

7. Bacteria embedded in a thick shiney barrier of sugars and protein

8. The upper outer layer of the two main layers of cells that make up the skin

9. It can be white or yellow in colour, and is made up of dead skin cells

10. A sweet sticky substance that has been used in wound care for 100's of years

<u>Down</u>

1. A dressing that adds moisture to a wound

2. Softening and breaking down of skin, resulting from prolonged exposure to moisture

4. A common bacterial skin infection

6. NICE guidelines recommend this product for debridement of necrotic, sloughy and long standing hyperkeratotic tissue
