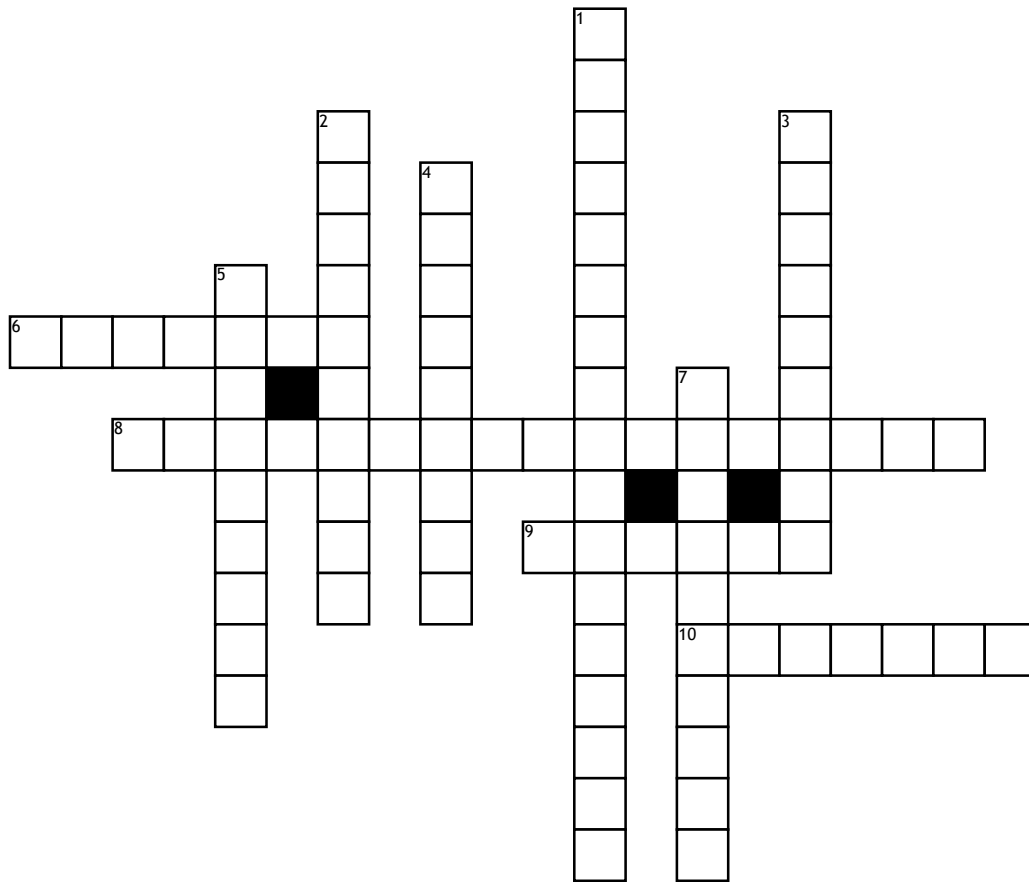

 3. Landforms that open to a pool of molten rock that can be changed due to destructive and constructive processes
 4. Land features that form when eroded sediment drops and builds up through the process of deposition
 5. Tallest landform on Earth that may go through changes due to destructive processes
 7. The breaking of larger rocks into smaller pieces called sediment
