

- **6.** Land features that are deep, v-shaped valleys, formed by water erosion
- **8.** This is the process that builds up Earth's surface and landforms
- **9.** Land features that form when eroded sediment drops at the mouth of the river
- **10.** Moves sediment from one place to another by wind, water, ice, gravity, and organisms **Down**
- **1.** Processes that wear away Earth's surface features and landforms

- 2. When sediment is released or dropped
- **3.** Landforms that open to a pool of molten rock that can be changed due to destructive and constructive processes
- **4.** Land features that from when eroded sediment drops and builds up through the process of deposition
- **5.** Tallest landform on Earth that may go through changes due to destructive processes
- 7. The breaking of larger rocks into smaller pieces called sediment
