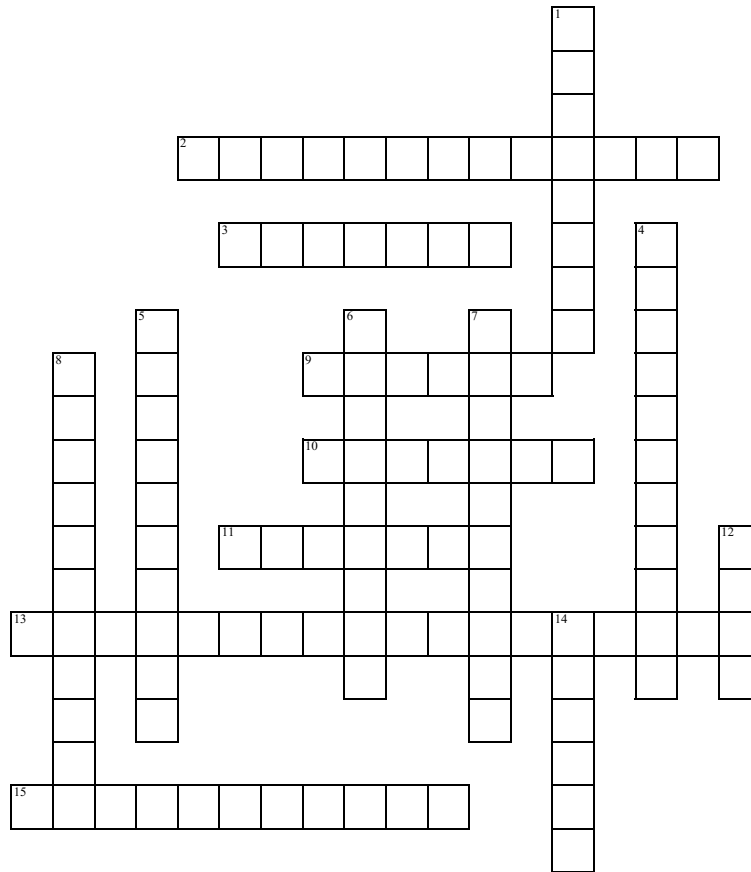


Juvenile Court System

2. An offense that would not be a crime if committed by an adult
3. To make a record of arrest
9. Serious crime like murder
10. A legal proceeding where an issue of law or fact is tried and evidence is presented to help determine the issue

15. Suspect enters a plea, if guilty, goes straight to sentencing

1. A child that is less than 17 years old
4. Process of negotiation, may plead guilty for lesser sentence
5. Declare the punishment decided for an offender
6. Person accused of committing a crime and goes in front of jury or judge
7. A formal charge or accusation of a serious crime
8. Less serious crime like assault
12. A body of people (typically twelve in number) sworn to give a verdict in a legal case on the basis of evidence submitted to them in court
