
Endocrine System

- 1. Secretes glucocorticoids, mineralocorticoids, and androgens; hormonal secretion is controlled by ACTH
- **4.** Anterior pituitary gland
- **8.** Endocrine gland that consists of an outer cortex and inner medulla
- 11. Organ that has both endocrine and exocrine functions
- 12. Small gland located in the brain; secretes melatonin and is invovled in regulating biorhythms
- **13.** Ductless glands that secrete hormones, usually into the blood for transport throughout the body

- **2.** Gland that secretes T3, T4, and calcitonin
- **3.** Lymphoid organ located in the mediastinum; plays an important role in immunity
- **5.** Gland that secretes parathyroid hormone and helps regulate calcium and phosphate



- **6.** The posterior pituitary gland; secretes oxytocin and antidurectic hormone
- 7. Classification of hormones secreted by the adrenal medulla; includes epinephrine and norepinephrine
- **9.** Substance secreted by an endocrine gland into the blood
- **10.** Lipid- soluable hormone such as estrogen, testosterine, and cortisol
