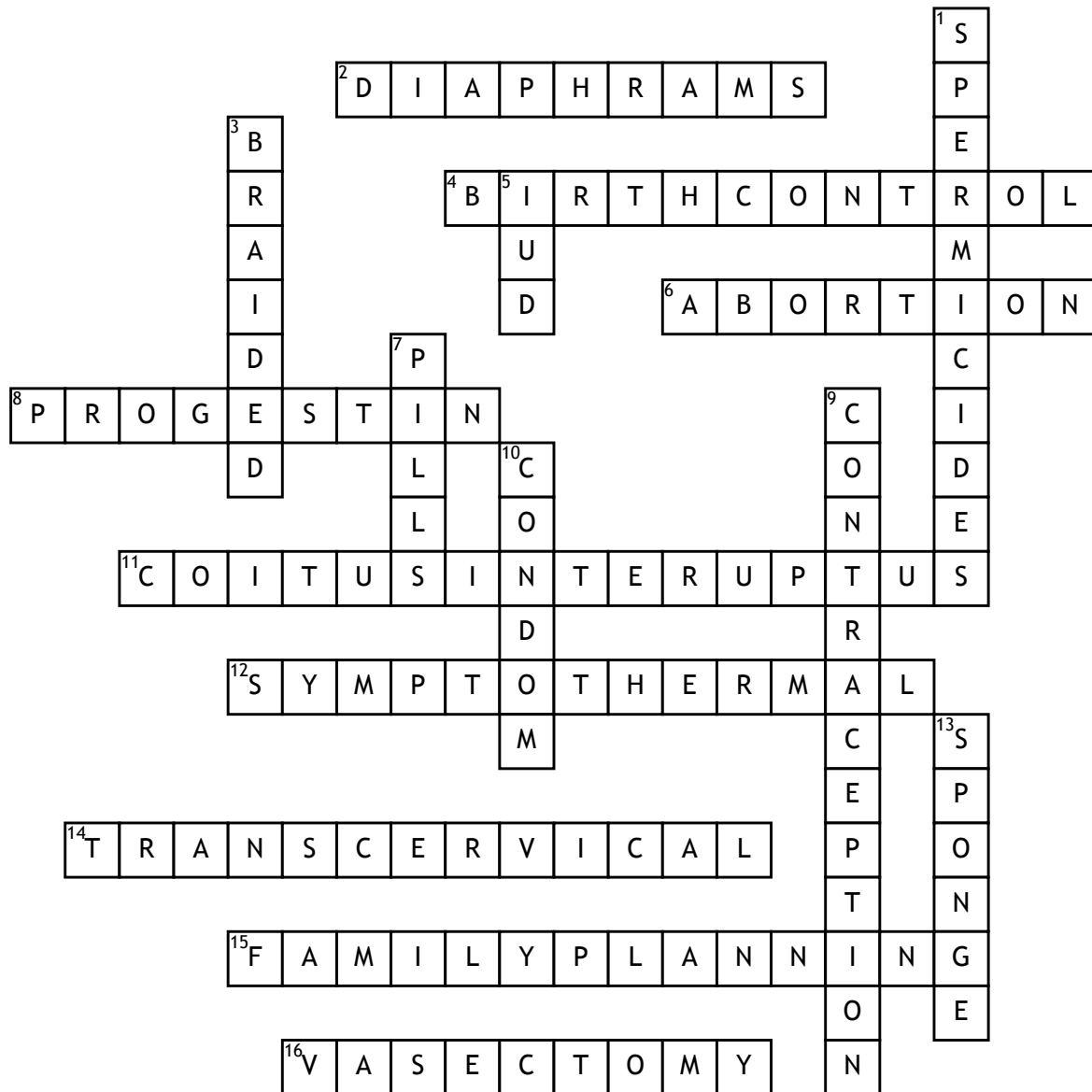


Birth Control Methods

2. Four types: coil spring, flat spring, arcing spring, wide seal rim
4. Device and/or practice to decrease the likelihood of conceiving or carrying a pregnancy to term
6. A form of birth control used to save the life or health of the mother
8. A form of birth control that can be oral, injectable, or implantable
11. This is the only acceptable form of contraception to the Roman Catholic Church

12. This method combines BBT and Cervical Mucus methods

14. A type of female sterilization where MD ejects occlusion agents into fallopian tubes

15. Consciously deciding when to avoid pregnancy during reproductive years

16. Easiest and most commonly used form of male sterilization
