

7. Characterized by full manic and major depressive episodes.

8. What last for at least one week and cause significant distress and impairment?

9. mild, but long-term form of depression. Defined as low mood occurring for at least two years, along with at least two other symptoms of depression.

10. loss of energy

11. a psychological disorder characterized by motional extremes.

1. Thoughts of death or suicide, or has suicide plan
