
COMMON LABORATORY EQUIPMENT



<u>Across</u>

 sits on the iron ring to provide a place to stand a beaker or an erlenmeyer flask and spread the heat uniformly on the bottom of the glassware
 stand that provides a safe and convenient way to perform reactions that require heating using a bunsenburner
 wide cylindrical glass container used to hold solids or liquids that are heated
 used to clean test tubes and graduated cylinders

12. used to accurately measure volumes of liquids
13. consists of a gas inlet, burner tube, air control vent and gas control
<u>Down</u>

 used to measure temperature
 used to manually stir solutions or transfer a single drop of solution
 connects to a ring stand to provide a stable, elevated platform for the reaction vessels **6.** has a spout that delivers a wash solution of water to a specific area

7. used to transfer a small volume of liquid(has a bulb at one end)

8. used for holding and organizing test tubes on the lab counter

10. glass finger length containers used for reacting and heating small amounts of chemicals
