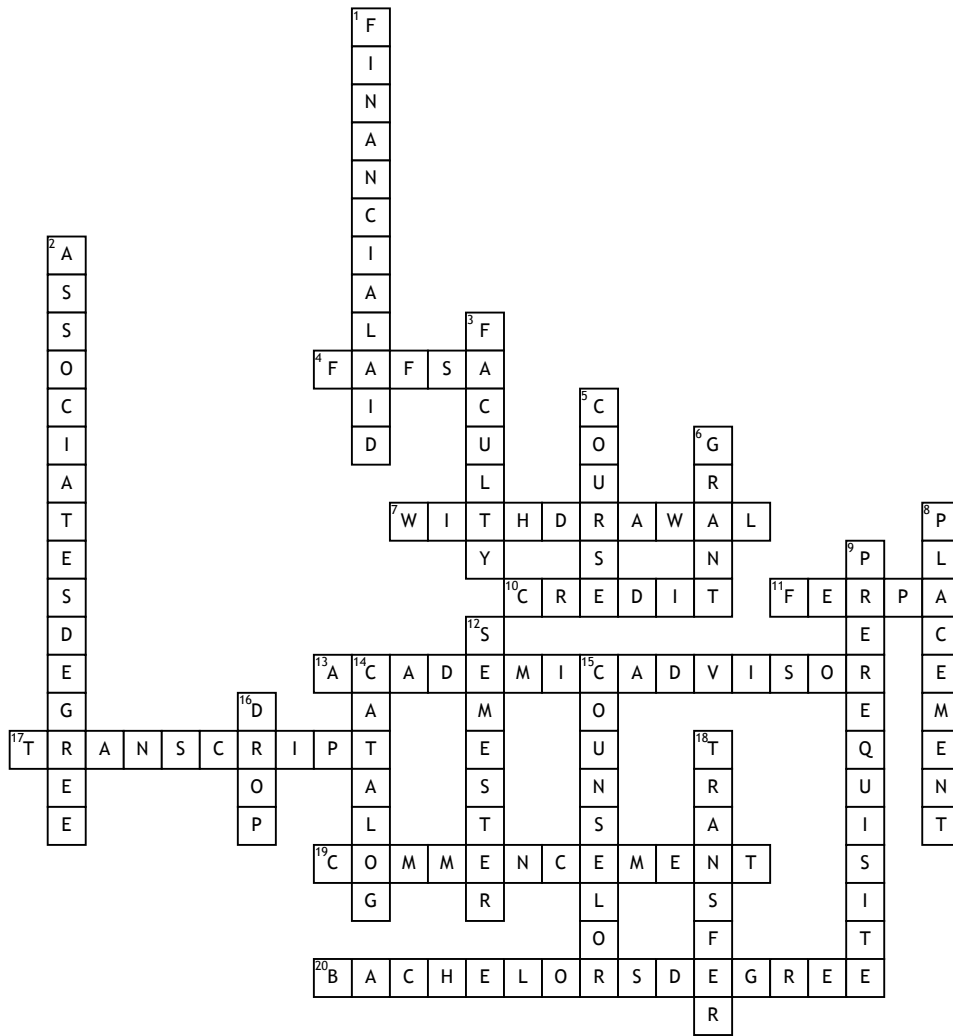

11. Enacted by the federal government, protects students' privacy and confidentiality by placing certain restrictions on the disclosure of educational records and information

13. a member of the college faculty or staff who assist students with planning semester schedules, career planning, transfer planning and long term educational goals

17. an official record of the courses and semester a student has taken at a college, the grades and degree or certificates earned and any honors received

19. ceremony at the end of an academic year when students receive their degree or diplomas

20. a college degree which can often be earned by following a four-year instructional program

2. a diploma earned after successfully completing a required program of study in a community college

3. the instructors or teaching staff at a school
