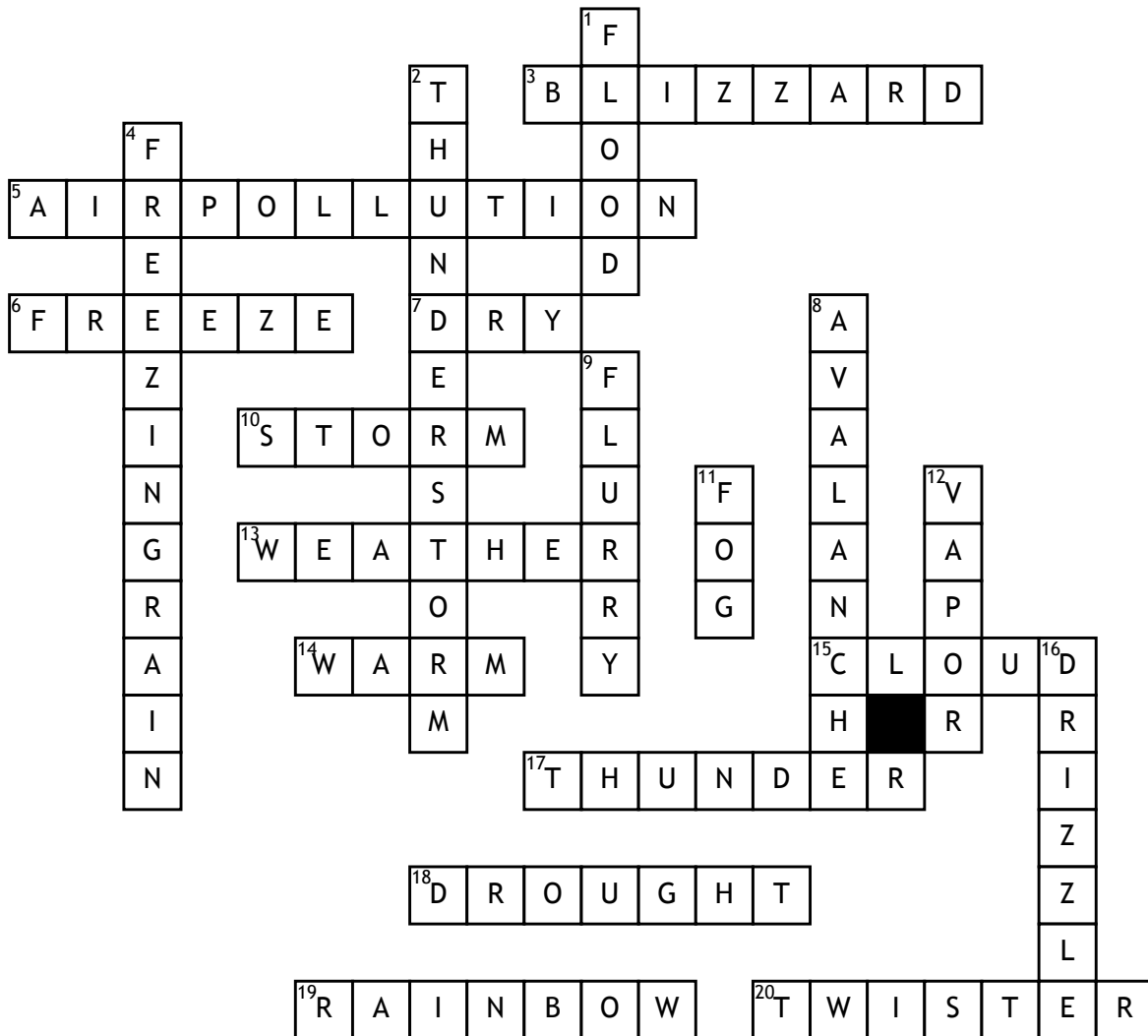

 5. the presence in or introduction into the air of a substance which has harmful or poisonous effects  
 6. (of a liquid) be turned into ice or another solid as a result of extreme cold  
 7. free from moisture or liquid; not wet or moist  
 10. a violent disturbance of the atmosphere with strong winds and usually rain, thunder, lightning, or snow  
 13. the state of the atmosphere at a place and time as regards heat, dryness, sunshine, wind, rain, etc  
 14. of or at a fairly or comfortably high temperature

15. a visible mass of condensed water vapor floating in the atmosphere typically high above the ground  
 17. a loud rumbling or crashing noise heard after a lightning flash due to expansion of rapidly heated air

 19. an arch of colors formed in the sky in certain circumstances caused by the refraction and dispersion of the sun's light by rain or other water droplets in the atmosphere  
 20. a tornado, waterspout, or dust devil in which the rotatory ascending movement of a column of air is especially apparent

 9. a small or swirling mass of something, especially snow or leaves moved by sudden gusts of wind  
 11. a thick cloud of tiny water droplets suspended in the atmosphere at or near the earth's surface that obscures or restricts visibility  
 12. a substance diffused or suspended in the air, especially one normally liquid or solid
