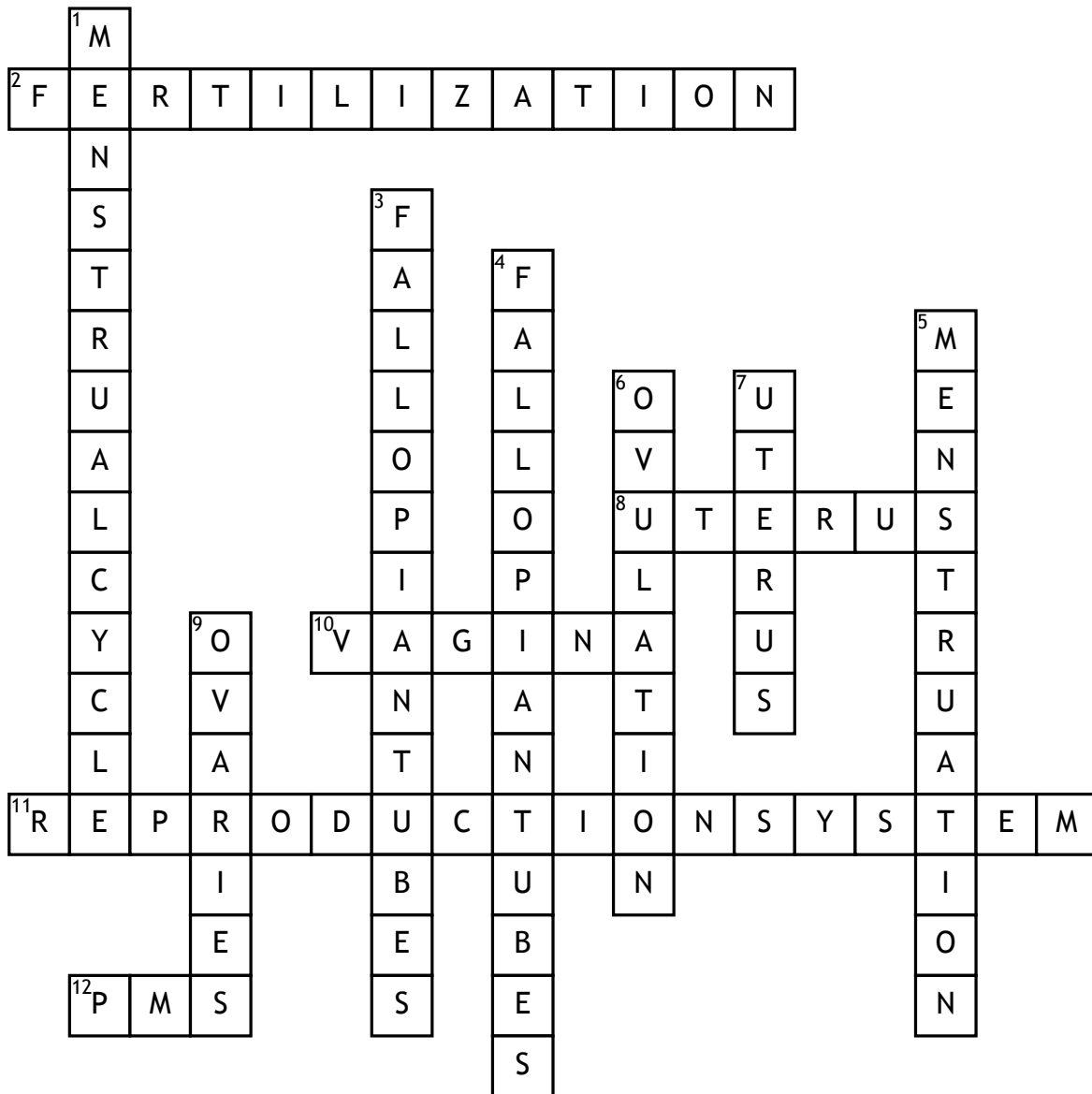


Female Reproduction System

1. Process in which the female body prepares for the fertilization of an egg cell

3. Tubes that lead to the uterus

4. Eggs are normally fertilized in this area

5. When blood, tissue and fluids flow from the body

6. When an egg is released and moves through the Fallopian tubes

7. Where the baby grows and develops

9. Control centers of the female reproductive system; holds the egg cells
