
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The Sensory System

- 4. Very thin layer
- **7.** Inflammation of the middle ear
- **9.** Snail-shaped spirally wound tube in the inner ear
- 11. Outer ear flap
- **12.** Visual examination of the ear canal with an otoscope
- **15.** Hardening of the bony tissue of the middle ear
- **17.** Ear wax
- **18.** Sensation of irregular or whirling motion either of oneself or external object

- **19.** Outermost layer of the eye
- **20.** Known as the blind spot **Down**
- 1. The central opening of the eve
- 2. Progressive damage to the macula of retina
- **3.** Loss of the ability to hear
- **5.** Allows muscle in the ciliary body to adjust the shape and thickness
- **6.** Clouding of the lens, causing decreased vision

- **8.** Sensation of noises in the ear; ringing in ears
- **10.** Measurement of the entire scope of vision
- **13.** Stirrup-shaped bone in the middle ear
- **14.** Colored layer that opens and closes to allow more or less light into eye
- 16. White part of the eye
