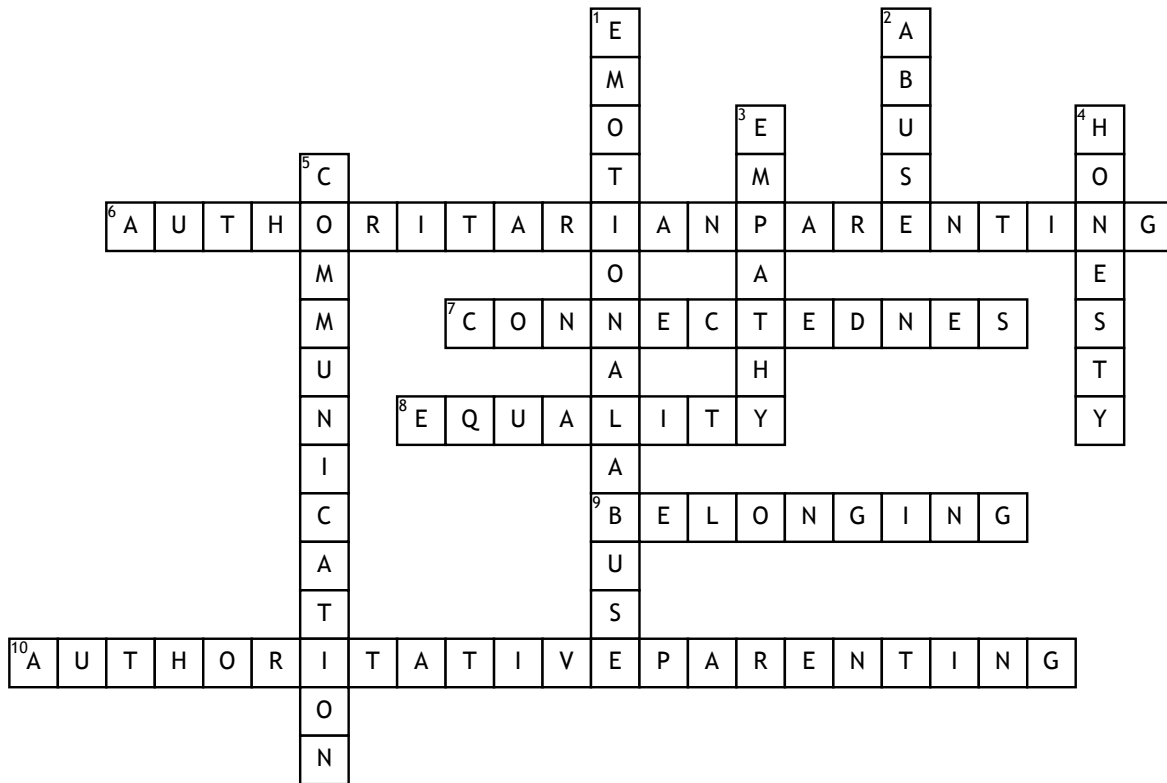


Respectful Relationships
