

## **Across**

- 3. Requirment that employees, especially teachers and other public employees, take one or two days off a month without pay
- **4.** The practice of separating students based on their academic abilites or other factors to receive instruction that is supposed to be most appropriate for their abilites
- **9.** Expectations and requirements that are enforced equally for all
- **13.** Chief Academic Officer, a position that provides districtwide leadership in relation to instruction, assessment, curriculum, and improvement of the overall quality of educational services
- **17.** Contracting with outside for-profit companies to provide services such as cleaning buildings, driving school buildings, or accounting
- **18.** Communication that moves up and down the organization chart of personnel in schools

- **19.** Parent-teacher organization, groups of teachers and parents that have organized to support student learning in a school
- **20.** Reduction in force, eliminating jobs due to budget cuts
- **21.** The degree to which there are sufficient funds to accomplish the objectives
- 22. Teachers of grades 9-12

## <u>Down</u>

- **1.** Communications across the various levels in the organization chart
- 2. Interactions with other members of the faculty and staff whom one does not supervise with the expectation that they will communicate, coordinate, and work together
- **5.** Policies or guidelines that set limits and specify the procedures that are to be used
- **6.** Total number of dollars spent divided by total number of students, indicator of a community's commitment to and support of public education

- 7. Funds spent during a specific school year
- **8.** CEO of a school district
- **10.** Local education agency, School districts that include a cluster of schools in the same geographic area
- 11. The tendency to become overly involved in the day-to-day operations of a school or school district
- **12.** The processes and administration of managing an organization for the purpose of making decisions and implementing actions
- **14.** An educational practice in which teachers remain with the same students for 2 or more grades
- **15.** Capacity to achieve as a result of physical or mental aptitude and training
- **16.** Chief state school officer, State superintendent of public instruction or commissioner of education
