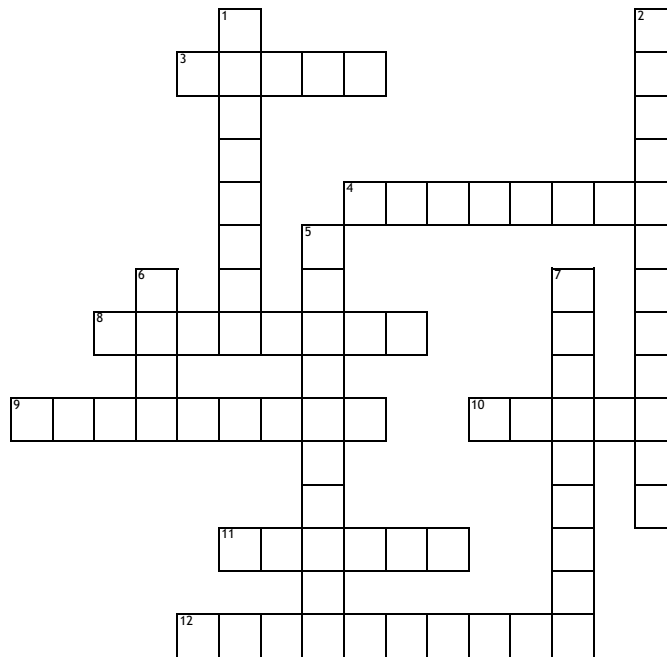


Elements of Literature
