

- **3.** Living skin at the base of the natural nail plate that covers the matrix
- 4. Lateral nail fold
- **5.** Portion of the living skin that supports the nail plate
- **9.** Dead, colorless tissue attached to the natural nail plate
- **11.** Area where the nail plate cells are formed
- **12.** The tissue bordering the root and sides of a fingernail or toenail
- **14.** When the nail is abnormal in shape or form

- **15.** Part of the nail plate that extends over the tip of the finger or toes
- **16.** Composed of several major parts of the fingernail
- **17.** Tough band of fibrous tissue that connects bones or holds an organ together
- **18.** Slightly thickened layer of skin under the nail that lies between the fingertip and free edge

1. Hardened keratin plate that sits on and covers the natural nail bed

- 2. Slightly thickened layer of skin under the nail that lies between the fingertip and free age
- **6.** Thin layer of tissue that attaches the nailplate and nail bed
- **7.** Also know as the onyx
- **8.** Fold of normal skin That surrounds the natural nail plate
- **10.** Whitish, halfmoon shape
- **13.** Furrow on each side of the nail
