
Female and Male anatomy

- **4.** Surrounds the urethra and secretes a fluid that helps the movement of sperm.
- 10. The organ used to release sperm in a sexual intercourse
- ${\bf 11.}$ The glands that produce the female sex hormones.
- 12. A storage area for sperm that links the testes with the vas deferens
- 13. Joins the uterus and the vagina
- $\textbf{14.} \ \textbf{A} \ \textbf{muscular pear-shaped organ that supports the developing baby.}$
- 15. Responsible for the production of sperm and testosterone.

Down

- 1. Loose pouch of skin that contains the testicles
- 2. This female body part joins the uterus to the outside of the body
- ${\bf 3.}$ Small glands that add fluid to the sperm to produce semen
- 5. extends from the ovary to the uterus to carry the egg after ovulation
- 6. Tube used to transport sperm and semen to the urethra and penis
- 7. Both females and males have this the final section of the large intestine.
- 8. Fold of skin the protects the opening of the vagina
- $\boldsymbol{9.}\ \boldsymbol{A}$ small sensitive organ located just above the vagina
