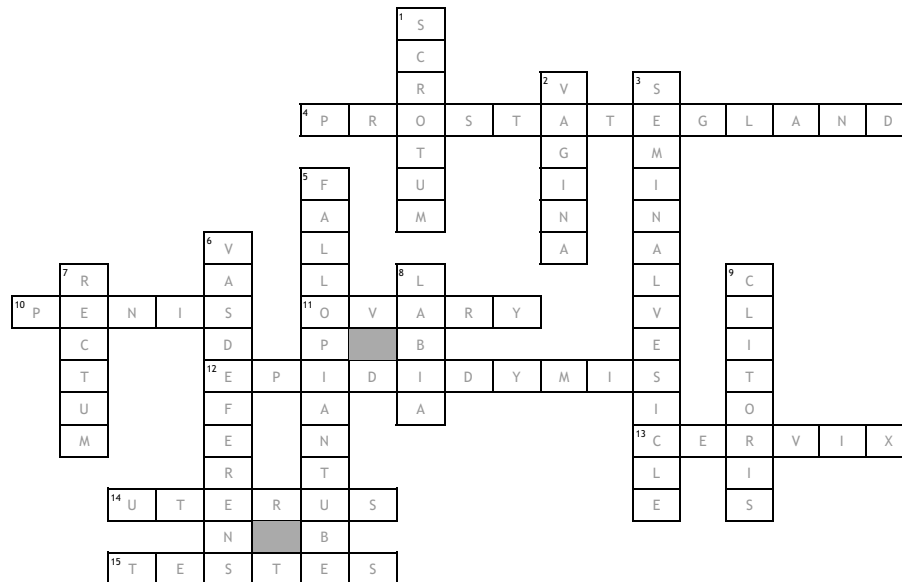


# Female and Male anatomy



## Across

4. Surrounds the urethra and secretes a fluid that helps the movement of sperm.
10. The organ used to release sperm in a sexual intercourse
11. The glands that produce the female sex hormones.
12. A storage area for sperm that links the testes with the vas deferens
13. Joins the uterus and the vagina
14. A muscular pear-shaped organ that supports the developing baby.
15. Responsible for the production of sperm and testosterone.

## Down

1. Loose pouch of skin that contains the testicles
2. This female body part joins the uterus to the outside of the body
3. Small glands that add fluid to the sperm to produce semen
5. extends from the ovary to the uterus to carry the egg after ovulation
6. Tube used to transport sperm and semen to the urethra and penis
7. Both females and males have this - the final section of the large intestine.
8. Fold of skin the protects the opening of the vagina
9. A small sensitive organ located just above the vagina
