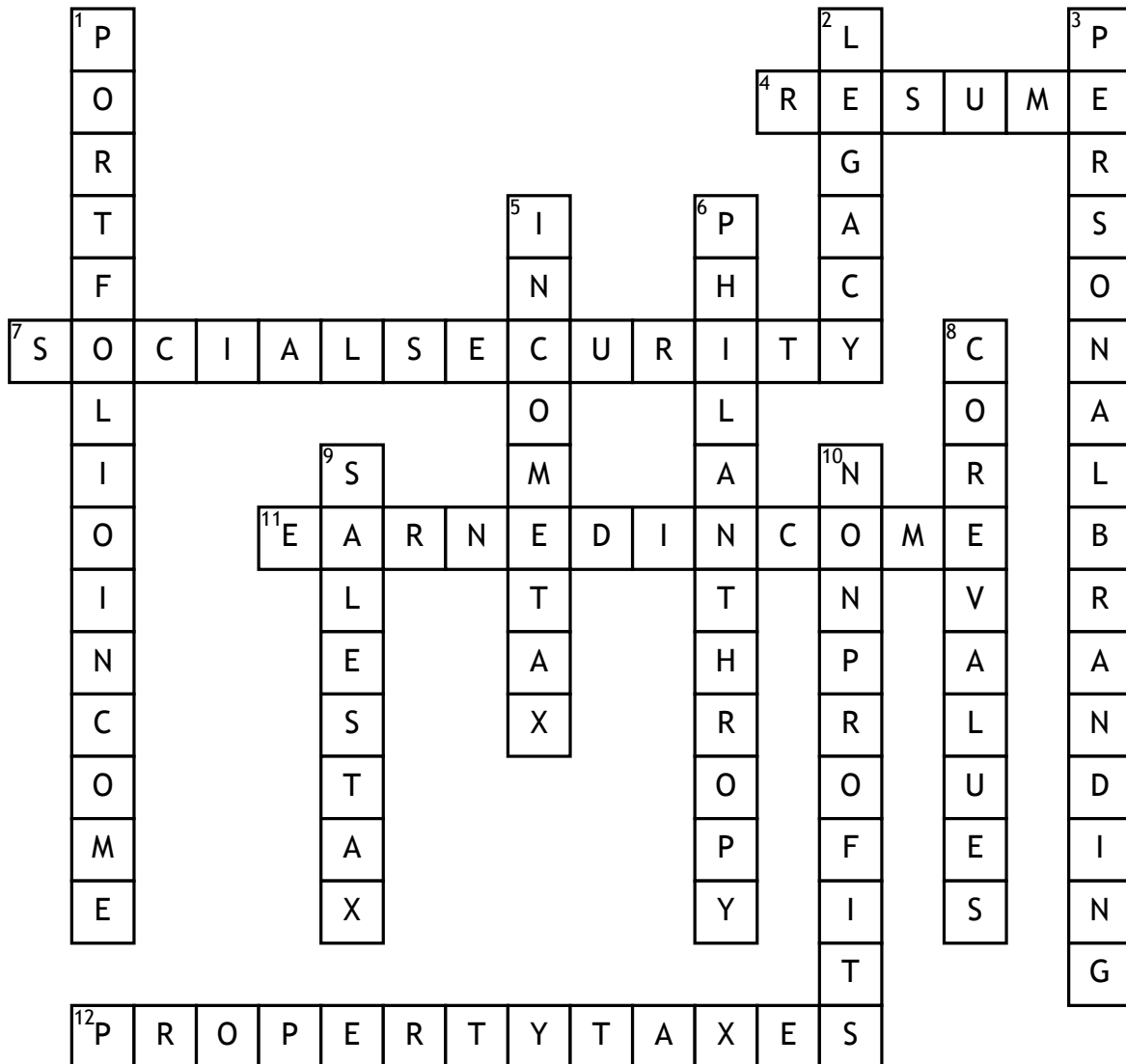


# Finance Vocabulary
