
Digestive System

- organic catalysts that speed up the digestive process
- 8. the process of breaking food down into simple substances to be absorbed by the body
- **10.** valve at the end of the esophagus
- 13. animals that have simple, one-compartment stomachs
- **14.** larger in diameter, shorter in length

- **16.** receives feed and adds chemicals that help with digestion
- 17. where bile is found
- **18.** tube-like passage from mouth to stomach
- **19.** grinds and squeezed feed/removes some liquid
- **20.** when the food is forced back up the esophagus to be chewed again
